I. Meeting with the Administration

Article 9 of the Consular Agreement Between the Government of the People's Republic of China And the Government of Canada (the PRC/Canada Agreement)

- 2. At the request of Mr James TO, the Administration agreed to explain in writing the practical arrangements between Hong Kong and Canada to implement Article 9 of the PRC/Canada Agreement, i.e. in relation to notification of death of a national of the sending State in the receiving State by competent authorities in the receiving State.
- 3. <u>Deputy Director of Administration</u> undertook to follow up with the Administration on the need to strengthen internal communication to ensure that the existing mechanism for informing the consular post of the death of their nationals in Hong Kong would work effectively.
