


CONFIDENTIAL**WRITTEN STATEMENT OF DR. TSANG HIN HUNG**

1. ^{AA} [REDACTED] was admitted to Intensive Care Unit (ICU) of Kwong Wah Hospital on 22 February 2003. He required mechanical ventilation to assist his breathing few hours after admission and sedative drugs were used as to facilitate mechanical ventilation.
2. I was on duty on 24 February 2003. At around 6:00 p.m., three doctors from Guangzhou came to the ICU to visit ^{AA} [REDACTED]. They were accompanied by Dr. Yip Wai Chun. They did not put on any mask or bring along any protective gears.
3. I explained to them the clinical history, course and treatment for ^{AA} [REDACTED]. The three doctors did not have any comments or suggestions on the medical treatment and they did not enter the isolation room as ^{AA} [REDACTED] was sedated and unconscious. They asked if we had found out the causative organisms of the pneumonia. I told them that the preliminary rapid tests for common respiratory pathogens were negative and some of the tests were still processing.
4. The three doctors stayed in the ICU for around ten minutes and left.
