In order to step up enforcement actions and associated works, the number of Buildings Department staff employed on contract terms is expected to increase to 685 in 2004-05. It comprises 119 professional staff (monthly salary \$31,300 - \$34,320), 434 technical staff (monthly salary \$12,250 - \$17,643) and 132 supporting staff (monthly salary \$6,500 -\$16,633). All the staff are employed on fixed contract terms for one year.
