Forecast of submissions for the 2003-04 Legislative Council session

This note gives an overview of potential capital works items to be submitted to the Public Works Subcommittee for consideration for the 2003-04 Legislative Council session.

- 2. The pool of items that may be ready for submission to the Public Works Subcommittee before the 2004 summer recess totals 80 as listed in Enclosure 1, including five already considered by the Subcommittee on 29 October 2003. To enable Members to have a better understanding of the items, we have provided supplementary information on each item at Enclosure 2 following the same order presented in Enclosure 1.
- 3. The Administration will try to adhere to the targets as much as possible. However, programme changes arising during the design, gazettal, and consultation stages, etc. are expected. We will account for deviations from the current forecast in a year-end report for Members' reference.

Project Code and Title: Provision for CWRF block allocations in 2004-05

Policy Bureau and Branch: Various controlling officers of CWRF block allocations

Works Department: Various works departments

Project Description:

To enable Members of FC and PWSC to make better use of their time and concentrate on the more important and higher value projects, FC has authorised the Administration to seek funding for the various block allocations on a lump-sum basis once every year. Within the lump sum approved for each CWRF block allocation, FC has further delegated to the Administration the power to approve expenditure on individual projects. The submission seeks PWSC's endorsement and FC's approval to the proposed total allocation for 2004-05 for various CWRF block allocations.

Indicative cost of the proposed project (Below \$200 million / \$200 million - \$500 million / Above \$500 million): Above \$500 million

Previous or planned panel consultation: We plan to consult the Legislative Council Panel on Planning, Lands and Works and Panel on Information Technology and Broadcasting in November/December 2003.

Project Code and Title: 6787TH – Hong Kong – Zhuhai – Macao Bridge Hong Kong Section and North Lantau Highway Connection – investigation and preliminary design

Policy Bureau and Branch: Environment, Transport and Works Bureau (Environment and Transport Branch)

Works Department: Highways Department

Project Description:

The proposed project is for the investigation and preliminary design of Hong Kong – Zhuhai – Macao Bridge (HZMB) Hong Kong Section (HKS) and North Lantau Highway Connection (NLHC). The latest proposed scope of the project comprises investigation of the HKS of HZMB and NLHC, including its longer term connection to Tai Ho; conceptual design of the HKS of HZMB; preliminary design of the NLHC; and associated site investigations and supervision. The investigation and preliminary design is tentatively scheduled to commence in 2003 - Q4 for completion in 2004 - Q4.

Indicative cost of the proposed project (Below \$200 million / \$200 million - \$500 million / Above \$500 million): Below \$200 million

Previous or planned panel consultation: On 29 September 2003, we sought the support of the Legislative Council Panel on Transport for a funding submission to be made to PWSC for an investigation and preliminary design study. The Panel had no objection to our funding proposal but requested for supplementary information on the proposed location of the landing point and the traffic impact of HZMB. We issued the supplementary paper on the above to the Panel on 21 October 2003, and further briefed Members at the Panel meeting on 24 October 2003. Upon Members' request, we issued another information note on 28 October 2003 to the Panel to provide further supplementary information on the basic assumptions for the traffic forecasts of the Bridge.

Project Code and Title: 5031DP – Chemical waste treatment facilities

Policy Bureau and Branch: Environment, Transport and Works Bureau (Environment and Transport Branch)

Works Department: Environmental Protection Department

Project Description:

The project is in Category A. The proposal for an increase in the approved project estimate is to enable the Chemical Waste Treatment Centre (CWTC) to receive clinical waste. The latest proposed scope comprises design and modification of the existing CWTC facilities for the reception, handling, storage and incineration of clinical waste. The design and construction are tentatively scheduled to commence in 2004 - Q1 for completion in 2005 - Q1.

Indicative cost of the proposed project (Below \$200 million / \$200 million - \$500 million / Above \$500 million): Below \$200 million

Previous or planned panel consultation: We briefed the Legislative Council Panel on Environmental Affairs (LegCo EA Panel) and Panel on Health Services (LegCo HS Panel) on the proposed alternative disposal facilities for clinical waste in the joint meetings on 30 May 1997 and 24 October 1997. We presented further information and reported the progress of the proposal to the LegCo EA Panel on 19 December 1997 and 20 February 1998.

We further briefed the LegCo EA Panel and LegCo HS Panel on 14 December 1999 and 7 February 2000. In mid 2000, we informed the Panels of the results of the dioxin emission study. We also briefed the Members in early 2002 on the results of the review of alternative treatment technologies for clinical waste. We presented the consultation result to the LegCo EA Panel on 23 May 2002.

We plan to consult the LegCo EA Panel on the proposed works in late 2003/early 2004.

Project Code and Title: 6731TH – Improvement to Castle Peak Road between Ka Loon Tsuen and Siu Lam

Policy Bureau and Branch: Environment, Transport and Works Bureau (Environment and Transport Branch)

Works Department: Highways Department

Project Description:

The proposed project is for the improvement to the Castle Peak Road between Ka Loon Tsuen and Siu Lam under a design and build (D&B) contract. The latest proposed scope of the project comprises widening of the existing Castle Peak Road from Ka Loon Tsuen to Tai Lam Kok to a dual two-lane carriageway; construction of a new dual two-lane viaduct between Tai Lam Kok and Siu Lam; and associated works on junction modification, slope stabilisation, landscaping, street lighting and drainage.

The D&B contract is tentatively scheduled to commence in 2004 - Q1 for completion in 2007 - Q2.

Indicative cost of the proposed project (Below \$200 million / \$200 million - \$500 million / Above \$500 million): Above \$500 million

Previous or planned panel consultation: We plan to consult the Legislative Council Panel on Transport on the proposed project in November 2003.

Project Code and Title: 7389RO – Enhancement of public facilities at Ngong Ping, Lantau

Policy Bureau and Branch: Economic Development and Labour Bureau (Economic Development Branch)

Works Department: Territory Development Department

Project Description:

The proposed project is for upgrading public facilities at Ngong Ping to complement the development of the Tung Chung Cable Car Project and its associated tourism developments at Ngong Ping. The latest scope of the project comprises the construction of a landscaped piazza fronting Po Lin Monastery, a combined emergency vehicular access and footpath, minor road improvement works on Ngong Ping Road (including a small roundabout and a short stretch of access road connecting the existing van track), associated stormwater drainage works, a public toilet and a police post within a new public transport interchange at Ngong Ping. The construction is tentatively scheduled to commence in 2004 - Q1 for completion in 2005 - Q4.

Indicative cost of the proposed project (Below \$200 million / \$200 million - \$500 million / Above \$500 million): Below \$200 million

Previous or planned panel consultation: We plan to consult the Legislative Council Panel on Economic Services on the proposed works in January 2004 following consultation with the Islands District Council.

Project Code and Title: 8086EB – Secondary school at Inverness Road, Kowloon Tong

Policy Bureau and Branch: Education and Manpower Bureau

Works Department: School sponsoring body – Hong Kong Institute of Contemporary Culture

Project Description:

The proposed project is for the construction of a secondary school at Inverness Road, Kowloon Tong. The latest proposed scope of the project comprises 30 classrooms, supporting rooms and ancillary facilities. The construction is tentatively scheduled to commence in 2004 - Q1 for completion in 2005 - Q3.

Project Code and Title: 8038EC – A direct subsidy scheme school (secondary-cum-primary) at Harmony Road, Siu Sai Wan

Policy Bureau and Branch: Education and Manpower Bureau

Works Department: School sponsoring body – Hon Wah Educational Organization Limited

Project Description:

The proposed project is for the construction of a secondary-cum-primary school at Harmony Road, Siu Sai Wan. The latest proposed scope of the project comprises a secondary section with 19 classrooms, a primary section with 18 classrooms, supporting rooms and other ancillary facilities. The construction is tentatively scheduled to commence in 2004 - Q1 for completion in 2005 - Q3.

Project Code and Title: 8044EC – A private independent school (secondary-cum-primary) at Shum Wan Road, Aberdeen

Policy Bureau and Branch: Education and Manpower Bureau

Works Department: School sponsoring body – Victoria Shanghai Education Foundation Limited

Project Description:

The proposed project is for the construction of a private independent school (secondary-cum-primary) at Shum Wan Road, Aberdeen. The latest proposed scope of the project comprises a secondary section with 36 classrooms, a primary section with 24 classrooms, supporting rooms and other ancillary facilities. The construction is tentatively scheduled to commence in 2004 - Q1 for completion in 2006 - Q1.

Project Code and Title: 8046EC – A private independent school (secondary-cum-primary) at Kong Sin Wan Tsuen, Pok Fu Lam

Policy Bureau and Branch: Education and Manpower Bureau

Works Department: School sponsoring body – Independent Schools Foundation Limited

Project Description:

The proposed project is for the construction of a private independent school (secondary-cum-primary) at Kong Sin Wan Tsuen, Pok Fu Lam. The latest proposed scope of the project comprises a secondary section with 30 classrooms, a primary section with 30 classrooms, supporting rooms and other ancillary facilities. The construction is tentatively scheduled to commence in 2004 - Q1 for completion in 2006 - Q2.

Project Code and Title: 3376RO – Improvement to Lei Yue Mun Park and

Holiday Village

Policy Bureau and Branch: Home Affairs Bureau

Works Department: Architectural Services Department

Project Description:

The proposed project is for the improvement of fire services equipment and enhancement of building safety inside the Lei Yue Mun Park and Holiday Village, Eastern District. The construction is tentatively scheduled to commence in 2004 - Q2 for completion in 2006 - Q3.

Project Code and Title: 3385RO – Tsim Sha Tsui Promenade Beautification Project

Policy Bureau and Branch: Economic Development and Labour Bureau (Economic Development Branch)

Works Department: Architectural Services Department

Project Description:

The proposed project is for the beautification of the Tsim Sha Tsui Promenade, which includes the outdoor area south of Salisbury Road outside Tsim Sha Tsui Star Ferry Pier concourse, the Hong Kong Cultural Centre, Hong Kong Museum of Art and the promenade along the Tsim Sha Tsui East waterfront up to the International Mail Centre. The latest proposed scope of the project comprises general landscape improvement; improvement works to the existing public toilet adjacent to the Star Ferry; reprovisioning of the existing Neighbourhood Police Unit; enhanced street lighting, alfresco dining facility; and provision of open space for street performances and outdoor activities. The project is tentatively scheduled to commence in 2004 - Q2 for completion in 2006 - Q1.

Indicative cost of the proposed project (Below \$200 million / \$200 million - \$500 million / Above \$500 million): Below \$200 million

Previous or planned panel consultation: We plan to consult the Legislative Council Panel on Economic Services on the proposed project on 24 November 2003.

Project Code and Title: 4064CD – Rural Drainage Rehabilitation Scheme – drainage rehabilitation works at Sha Po Tsuen Stream

Policy Bureau and Branch: Environment, Transport and Works Bureau (Works Branch)

Works Department: Drainage Services Department

Project Description:

The proposed project is for the construction of drainage rehabilitation works at Sha Po Tsuen in Kam Tin. The latest proposed scope of the project comprises the construction of drainage channels of a total length of about 700 metres with associated maintenance access alongside the channel as well as the re-provisioning of one vehicular and one pedestrian crossing. The tentative schedule is to commence construction in 2004 - Q2, and to complete the drainage channels in 2006 - Q3 and the remaining works in 2007 - Q1.

We sought funding from the Finance Committee –

- (a) on 4 November 1994 for part-upgrading for employing consultants to carry out environmental impact assessment and site investigations for the Rural Drainage Rehabilitation Scheme, and detailed design for the part of the works in North East New Territories;
- (b) on 12 December 1997 for part-upgrading for construction of drainage rehabilitation works at Ng Tung River;
- (c) on 16 October 1998 for part-upgrading for construction of drainage rehabilitation works at Sheung Yue River;
- (d) on 17 December 1999 for part-upgrading for construction of drainage rehabilitation works at Nam Hang Tsuen; and
- (e) on 20 December 2002 for part-upgrading for construction of drainage rehabilitation works at Ping Yuen River and Mo Fan Heung Stream.

Project Code and Title: 4143DS – Central, Western and Wan Chai West sewerage, stage 2 phase 2B works

Policy Bureau and Branch: Environment, Transport and Works Bureau (Environment and Transport Branch)

Works Department: Drainage Services Department

Project Description:

The proposed project is for the improvement of existing sewers in Central and Western districts. The latest proposed scope of the project comprises the construction of about 8.4 kilometres of sewers with diameters ranging from 225 millimetres (mm) to 1 400 mm and rectification of the expedient connections in Central and Western districts. The construction is tentatively scheduled to commence in 2004 - Q2 for completion in 2007 - Q3.

We sought funding from the Finance Committee –

- (a) on 22 April 1994 for part-upgrading for employing consultants to carry out detailed design, investigation, environmental and traffic impact assessments for the whole project;

The proposed project is to continue with the environmental monitoring work for the urban landfills. The latest proposed scope of the project comprises the operation and maintenance of the landfill gas and leachate management systems, environmental monitoring and audit, landscape maintenance, and maintenance of site infrastructure. The environmental monitoring work will continue for a further period of seven years (i.e. from May 2005 to May 2012).

We have previously sought funding from the Finance Committee on 9 June 1995 for construction of the restoration facilities and the first term of seven-year environmental monitoring work in urban landfills.

Previous or planned panel consultation: We plan to consult the Legislative Council Panel on Environmental Affairs on the need to continue with the existing post-completion environmental monitoring work at urban landfills in January 2004.
