### **Supplementary information on 376RO – Improvement Works to Lei Yue Mun Park and Holiday Village**

#### **INTRODUCTION**

At the Public Works Subcommittee meeting held on 12 November 2003, Members, after considering paper PWSC(2003-04)53 on project **376RO** “Improvement Works to Lei Yue Mun Park and Holiday Village (LYMPHV)”, requested the Administration to provide additional information on –

- (a) the estimated cost for the provision of fire services installations for the canteen at Block 4 of the LYMPHV; and
- (b) the results of the opinion survey conducted among the campers of the LYMPHV on its facilities.

#### **Cost Estimation**

2. The estimated cost for the provision of fire services improvement and the associated builder works, including sprinkler systems etc., for the canteen at Block 4 of the LYMPHV is about \$2 million.

#### **Opinion Survey**

3. With a view to enhancing service quality, campers of government holiday camps are invited to comment on the services provided at the end of their visit. For the LYMPHV, a total of 1 357 questionnaires were returned by campers in the past two years. Results indicated that over 80% of the campers either were satisfied with the facilities provided or found the facilities acceptable. A detailed breakdown of the results on the satisfaction level of the opinion survey is at the Enclosure.

4. To enhance the recreational services and dormitory facilities at the LYMPHV, some improvement works have been carried out in 2002 and 2003 as part of the regular improvement programmes. These include provision of a variety of additional play equipments for children, replacement of bicycles and American Pool tables, and replacement of air conditioners and bedding in the dormitories.

5. In addition to upgrading the existing facilities at the LYMPHV to comply with the latest licensing requirements, the present project also includes the reprovisioning of children's play equipment in the playground and development of a fitness and Tai Chi area.
