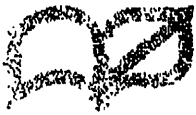
2. The recommendation of PWSC on the item will be considered by the Finance Committee at its meeting on 5 December 2003.

Follow-up to meeting on 29 October 2003

The Secretary for Financial Services and the Treasury has referred your e-mail of 3 December 2003 to us for a reply direct. As requested by the Honourable Member, I am writing to provide the list of schools which have been withdrawn from the final phase of the School Improvement Programme (SIP) at the feasibility study stage.

For the 61 primary and one special schools which were withdrawn from the SIP because of impending closure due to phasing out of classes or housing estate redevelopment, the list is at Annex A. For the four primary, one secondary and three special schools which were withdrawn from the SIP because of impending reprovisioning or in-situ redevelopment plans, the list is at Annex B.



As regards the 20 primary and one special schools with the existence of vacant classrooms, low enrolment or limited room for significant improvement to facilities for which SIP is not justified or could not be agreed with the school sponsors, the Administration considers it not appropriate to disclose their names as the publicity that goes with it might inadvertently cause undesirable effect on schools' efforts in attracting prospective students. I sincerely hope that the Honourable Member would appreciate our difficulties. If necessary we would be happy to discuss the issue with the Honourable Member direct.
