Wording of the Motion

“That this Council regrets that the Task Force on Constitutional Development’s trip to Beijing lacks transparency and urges the Government to immediately consult the public on whether the Chief Executive and all Members of the Legislative Council should be elected by universal suffrage in 2007 and 2008 respectively, collate the public’s views received in an impartial manner, and accurately relay them to the Central Government.”
