Wording of the Motion

“That this Council urges the Task Force on Constitutional Development to consult, in a pragmatic manner, the public on concrete proposals of constitutional reform, to avoid unnecessary arguments, causing social polarisation and instability; and to express to the Central Government that the principles prescribed in the Basic Law shall be respected and complied with in implementing constitutional reform.”
