- (a) request the Administration to consider repealing the Chinese Medicine Ordinance (Cap. 549) (Commencement) (No. 2) Notice 2003, Chinese Medicine (Fees) Regulation (Cap. 549 sub. leg. E) (Commencement) (No. 2) Notice 2003 and the Chinese Medicines Regulation (Cap. 549 sub. leg. F) (Commencement) (No. 2) Notice 2003. If the Administration did not agree to do so, the Chairman of the Subcommittee would move amendments to repeal the three Commencement Notices as agreed at the last meeting;
- (b) extend the scrutiny period of the three Commencement Notices to 17 December 2003 so as to allow time for the Administration to respond to the request in (a) above; and
- (c) recommend to the House Committee that the relevant Panel(s) or a subcommittee should follow up with the Administration to review the implementation of the Chinese Medicine Ordinance and related Regulations.

3. Members also agreed that the Administration should be requested to provide a written response to paragraph 2(a) above.
