2. <u>PWP Item 45DR — Restoration of Pillar Point Valley Landfill (PPVL)</u> 2.1 <u>Noise Control (Amendment) Ordinance 2002 Codes of Practice on Good Management Practice</u>	26.5.03	The Administration to provide - (a) the amount of landfill gas produced at PPVL, the amount of electricity that could be generated and the amount of landfill gas that would be burnt; and (b) information on how landfill gas produced at PPVL could be put to use, the total financial commitment in restoring PPVL and the unit restoration cost of the waste disposed of at PPVL if the costs of the restoration and post-commissioning works were included. The Administration to consult the trades and industries concerned and provide the Panel with a report on the outcome of consultation.	The information has been included in the Public Works Subcommittee (PWSC) paper for the project which has been approved by Finance Committee in July 2003.

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3. <u>Restoration of Shuen Wan Landfill - post-completion environmental monitoring work</u>	27.10.03	The Administration to provide - (a) information on the content of landfill gas and leachate of SWL as well as the types of tests conducted in the submission to the PWSC; and (b) a comparison table on the costs of restoration and post-completion environmental monitoring work incurred for different landfills. 3.1 <u>Management of construction and demolition materials</u>	27.10.03	The Administration to provide - (a) a comparison on the environmental impact of using dredged mud and soft inert materials for capping mud pits at East Sha Chau should be made; (b) a breakdown on the generation and disposal of C&D materials in the form of a balance sheet; ;and (c) overseas experience in the implementation of LCS and the charging arrangement in other countries.
