I. Election of Chairman and Deputy Chairman

Mr SIN Chung-kai, Chairman of the Panel in office, chaired the meeting and invited nominations for the chairmanship. Mr SIN Chung-kai was nominated by Mr CHAN Wai-yip and seconded by Dr LAW Chi-kwong. As Mr SIN was nominated for the chairmanship and accepted the nomination, Mr Howard YOUNG, Deputy Chairman of the Panel in office, presided over the election of Chairman.

- 2. There being no other nomination, <u>Mr Howard YOUNG</u> declared that Mr SIN Chung-kai was elected Chairman of the Panel for the 2003-2004 session.
- 3. Mr SIN Chung-kai took the chair and called for nominations for the deputy chairmanship. Mr Howard YOUNG was nominated by <u>Dr LAW Chikwong</u> and seconded by <u>Mr YEUNG Yiu-chung</u>. <u>Mr YOUNG</u> accepted the nomination.
- 4. There being no other nomination, the Chairman declared that Mr Howard YOUNG was elected Deputy Chairman of the Panel for the 2003-2004 session.

5. <u>Members</u> agreed that the regular monthly meetings of the Panel would be held on the second Monday of each month at 2:30 pm except for October 2003 and April 2004 which were rescheduled to be held on Thursday, 23 October 2003 at 2:30 pm and Monday, 19 April 2004 at 8:30 am respectively.

- 6. <u>Members</u> agreed to discuss the following agenda items at the next Panel meeting to be held on 23 October 2003:
 - (a) "Consultation paper on draft merger guideline for Hong Kong telecommunication markets"
 - originally scheduled for discussion at the special Panel meeting on 29 September 2003 but was deferred at the request of the telecommunication operators; and
 - (b) "Proposal to host the International Telecommunication Union TELECOM WORLD 2006"
 - a funding proposal to be submitted to the Finance Committee.
- 7. <u>Members</u> also decided to discuss the following items at the Panel meeting to be held on 10 November 2003:
 - (a) "Building a digitally inclusive information society and related issues"proposed by Dr Hon LAW Chi-kwong in connection with the World Summit on Information Society; and
 - (b) "Public consultation paper on 2004 Digital 21 Strategy"
 - proposed by the Administration.
- 8. On 7(a), <u>members</u> also agreed that deputations which had submitted views to the Panel on issues related to "digital divide" would be invited to attend the meeting. A general notice inviting submissions from the public would also be posted on the website of the Council.
