Bills Committee on Companies (Amendment) Bill 2004 Third meeting on 13 January 2005

Proposed Work Plan

Purpose

This paper aims to set out the proposed work plan for the Bills Committee's scrutiny of the Companies (Amendment) Bill 2004 (the Bill) for members' consideration.

Background

2. At the last Bills Committee meeting held on 16 December 2004, the Chairman invited the Administration to work out the matters to be discussed by the Bills Committee and the number of meetings required for each matter, and the Clerk to work out a meeting schedule accordingly. The Chairman indicated that future meetings would be held at an interval of around 3 weeks.

Proposed work plan

3. Having regard to various factors such as the complexity of the various provisions contained in the Bill, a tentative work plan has been drawn up by the Administration as follows -

^{*} The proposed new definition for "subsidiary" is mainly set out in the new section 2B and the Twenty-Third Schedule of the Companies Ordinance. It is therefore suggested that clause 18 be scrutinized before clauses 3 to 17.

Proposed meeting schedule

4. Given the Administration's current estimate that four more meetings may be required for completing the scrutiny of the Bill and the possible need for addition of meetings towards the end of the scrutiny period for detailed examination of individual clauses and draft CSAs, the Clerk has worked out a proposed meeting schedule with seven meeting slots for the period from February to May 2005. The seven meeting slots are at an interval of around

2.5 or 3 weeks. The proposed meeting schedule is set out below for members' consideration:
