3. At the request of the Bills Committee, <u>the Administration</u> agreed to report the findings of the study on a generic legislation governing bank mergers and reorganizations in Hong Kong undertaken by the Financial Services and the Treasury Bureau and the Hong Kong Monetary Authority to the Panel on Financial Affairs within the next few months.

Clause-by-clause examination of the Bill

4. <u>Members</u> noted that the Bill was similar to the previous bills on bank mergers and reorganizations and there were no technical and drafting problems with the Bill. <u>The Bills Committee</u> agreed that there was no need to examine clause by clause as members had already discussed the Bill with the Administration and the Citibank on matters of concern.

- 5. <u>Members</u> supported the Bill and agreed to report to the House Committee on 6 May 2005, recommending the resumption of the Second Reading debate on the Bill at the Council meeting on 25 May 2005. Members noted that the deadline for giving notice of Committee Stage amendments would be 14 May 2005.
