#### II. Meeting with the Administration

(LC Paper No. CB(2)54/04-05(01))

- 2. The Bills Committee deliberated (Index of proceedings at **Annex**).
- 3. <u>The Bills Committee</u> requested the Administration to provide in writing to the following information requested by members at the meeting -
  - (a) a breakdown of the annual sales figures generated by those orally consumed products making claims relating to the regulation of the immune system, the promotion of detoxification and slimming/fat reduction;
  - (b) reason(s) for not regulating those orally consumed products making claims on the regulation of the immune system and the promotion of detoxification based on scientific/medical grounds;
  - (c) composition and membership of the Expert Committee set up at the end of 2002 to study and recommend a list of health claims to be prohibited in orally consumed products;

- (d) details of the divided views on the regulation of claims relating to the regulation of the immune system, the promotion of detoxification and slimming/fat reduction referred to in paragraph 23 of the Legislative Council Brief on the Bill; and
- (e) statistics on the so-called "health food" products found to have contained dangerous/prohibited drug(s) during random inspection by the Department of Health in the past year.
- 4. <u>The Bills Committee</u> also requested the Administration to provide in writing the following suggestions/questions raised by members at the meeting -
  - (a) requiring the packaging of the so-called "health food" products to state a list of ingredients contained;
  - (b) requiring the advertisement and the packaging of the orally consumed products claiming health benefits to include a warning that people should seek medical help if they felt unwell after consuming the products;
  - (c) how the interests of the consumers could be safeguarded in view of the Administration's decision not to regulate orally consumed products making claims relating to the regulation of the immune system, the promotion of detoxification and slimming/fat reduction; and
  - (d) the possibility of including the three types of claims relating to the regulation of the immune system, the promotion of detoxification and slimming/fat reduction in the Bill.
