#### Action

### I. Meeting with the Administration

[LC Paper Nos. CB(2)1182/05-06(01)]

<u>The Bills Committee</u> deliberated the Administration's paper on "Quorum of a management committee (MC) and other related matters" [LC Paper No. CB(2)1182/05-06(01)] (Index of proceedings is at **Annex**).

#### Filling of vacancies in an MC

2. <u>Members</u> in general supported the Administration's proposal of introducing Committee Stage amendments (CSAs) to expand paragraph 6(2) of Schedule 2 along the line of paragraph 6(1B) so that a causal vacancy in an MC could be filled either by the MC or the owners' corporation (OC) at a general meeting. <u>Members</u> considered that in order to avoid the need to trigger the mechanism under sections 30 and 31 of the Building Management Ordinance (BMO), a set of simplified and clear procedures should be provided for owners to appoint MC members to fill the casual vacancies in case the size of MC dropped to below the quorum (i.e. 50%). They had made the following suggestions -

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(a) the chairman of an MC should be allowed to convene an owners' meeting under paragraph 1(2) of Schedule 3 to fill casual vacancies in the MC <u>even without</u> having received a request of not less than 5% of the owners, provided that the meeting was held solely for the purpose of passing a resolution to fill the vacancies;

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- (b) the list of agents who could apply under section 31 of BMO to the Lands Tribunal for the appointment of an administrator should be expanded as far as possible;
- (c) an inquorate MC should be allowed to convene a meeting to appoint a temporary chairman among its members whose role was only to convene a meeting for the purpose of passing a resolution to fill the casual vacancies in an MC; and
- (d) the Authority could order that an owners' meeting be convened for such purpose if there was no litigation involved.
- 3. <u>Members</u> considered that consultation with professional bodies in the building management sector on the relevant CSAs to be prepared would be required. <u>The Chairman</u> also reminded the Administration that when devising the procedures as suggested in paragraph 2(c) and (d) above, the Administration had to work out operational details such as who would be given the authority to determine and cross-check the validity of proxies received.
- 4. Mr WONG Kwok-hing proposed that a mechanism should be put in place under BMO to provide for a waiting list of candidates for appointment to fill casual vacancies in an MC. The list would be made up of nominees who had lost by a narrow margin during a previous election for the appointment of MC members held at an owners' meeting. Some other members, however, expressed reservation about the proposal. They considered that the proposal might give rise to disputes and it would be more appropriate to leave the matter to the MC to decide.

#### Terms of the members appointed to fill vacancies

5. <u>Members</u> in general supported the Administration's proposal of introducing CSAs to amend paragraph 6(1B) and (2) of Schedule 2 to the effect that the corporation may, by a resolution passed at a general meeting of the corporation, appoint an owner to fill the vacancy in the MC (including the chairman, vice-chairman, secretary, treasurer or other members) and the terms of such appointment would end at the next alternate general meeting convened under paragraph 5 of Schedule 2 where all members shall retire.

#### Size of an MC

6. <u>Members</u> raised no objection to the Administration's proposal of introducing CSAs to include a new paragraph in Schedule 2 to stipulate that all owners' meetings could pass resolutions regarding the size of an MC (without prejudice to the statutory minimum stipulated in paragraph 1(a) of Schedule 2)

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and such new appointments should last till the next alternate annual general meeting when all members retired.

#### Voting system for the appointment of MC members

7. <u>Members</u> noted that while the Bills Committee was in general supportive of the Administration's proposal of adopting the "first past the post" voting system for the appointment of members of MC, it had not been discussed whether voting would be required if the number of nominees was the same as the minimum number of persons to constitute the MC. <u>Mr Albert HO</u> suggested the Administration to consider whether it would be feasible to endorse the appointment of these nominees as MC members by a resolution passed at the owners' meeting so that voting would not be required. <u>Members</u> agreed that the Administration should study the issue and the Bills Committee would follow up the issue when considering the relevant draft CSAs to be prepared by the Administration.
