#### I. Confirmation of minutes

#### II. Meeting with the Administration

[LC Paper Nos. CB(2)222/05-06(03) and CB(2)342/05-06(01)]

- 2. The Bills Committee discussed issues relating to
  - (a) jurisdiction of Lands Tribunal and failure/delay of the chairman of a management committee (MC) to convene meetings of an owners' corporation (OC) in the Administration's paper entitled "The Administration's response to views of the professional bodies in the building management sector" [LC Paper No. CB(2)222/05-06(03)]; and
  - (b) appointment of an MC, protection for and qualifications of MC members, composition and procedure of MC, appointment of proxy by owners, termination of the appointment of managers, procurement by OCs and managers, setting up of funds, and accounts of corporation in the Administration's paper entitled "The Administration's response to the views of the deputations attending the meeting on 25 June 2005" [LC Paper No. CB(2)342/05-06(01)].

#### Jurisdiction of Lands Tribunal

Members in general considered that the Lands Tribunal should have exclusive jurisdiction on building management matters although it would not be necessary to pursue the issue in the current legislative exercise. members' request, the Administration undertook to consider the issue in collaboration with the Judiciary in the context of taking forward the proposal of setting up the Building Affairs Tribunal, and revert to the Panel on Home Affairs, or the Bills Committee if possible, on progress made.

Failure/delay of an MC to convene annual general meetings of a corporation

Admin The Administration was requested to confirm whether any provisions of 4. the Building Management Ordinance (BMO) could be invoked to compel the holding of an overdue annual general meeting of an OC; and if not, to consider how to plug the loophole.

> Penalties against non-compliance with existing or proposed new provisions of **BMO**

- 5. Regarding concerns raised by the Chairman and Mr Albert HO, the Administration was requested to consider –
  - (a) how the proposed new provisions of BMO would be enforced in the absence of penalties provided for under the Ordinance; and
  - (b) the concept of civil penalties and imposition of such penalties under BMO.

Suggestion of granting an MC the discretionary power to decide on its own that it could convene a meeting of the MC at less than seven days' notice

- The Administration was requested to consider the following suggestions raised by Mr Albert HO -
  - (a) that a mechanism should be provided for under BMO whereby an MC could authorise some of its members to form a working group responsible for handling urgent matters as well as budgetary matters which involved expenses not exceeding a stipulated amount; and
  - a shorter notice could be allowed for convening a meeting of an (b) MC provided that 75% to 80% of the MC members consented that there was an urgent need to convene the meeting.
