### I. Confirmation of minutes

- 2. The Bills Committee discussed -
  - (a) items S to W in the paper entitled "Consolidated Response The Administration's response to Members' suggestions/views" [LC Paper No. CB(2)2368/05-06(01)]; and
  - (b) the paper entitled "Supplementary Consolidated Response The Administration's response to Members' suggestions/views" [LC Paper No. CB(2)3038/05-06(01)], except for items H, J and K of the paper.

#### Action

Regulation of property management companies [Item S of LC Paper No. CB(2)2368/05-06(01)]

- 3. <u>Mr WONG Kwok-hing</u> requested to put on record his view that the Administration should strive to complete its consultancy study on the feasibility of introducing a regulatory scheme for property management companies and work out a proposal on the way forward as early as possible.
- 4. <u>Ms Miriam LAU</u> suggested that if the Administration was to introduce a regulatory scheme for property management companies, consideration should be given to combining such a scheme with the existing regulatory scheme for the security and guarding services industry, in order to avoid requiring companies which provided security as well as property management services to apply for two licences.

Obligations after manager's appointment ends [Item U of LC Paper No. CB(2)2368/05-06(01)]

- 5. <u>The Administration</u> was requested to revise its proposal having regard to the following members' concerns and suggestions -
  - (a) as an outgoing manager might have an implied obligation under the appointment contract to surrender immediately after his appointment ended any movable property in respect of the control, management and administration of the building that was under his control or in his custody or possession, it would be against the owners' interest if he was given 14 days to do so as proposed by the Administration;
  - (b) paragraph 8 of the Seventh Schedule should be amended to the effect that the outgoing manager had to -
    - (i) deliver, <u>immediately after his appointment ended</u>, to the owners' committee or the manager appointed in his place any <u>keys</u> in respect of the control, management and administration of the building that was under his control or in his custody or possession; and
    - (ii) deliver, within 14 days after his appointment ended, to the owners' committee or the manager appointed in his place any books or records of account, papers, documents and other records in respect of the control, management and administration of the building that was under his control or in his custody or possession.

**Action** 

Borrowing power of owners' corporations (OCs) [Item W of LC Paper No. CB(2)2368/05-06(01)]

6. <u>Members</u> noted that it was the Administration's position that the current proposal set out in its paper [LC Paper No. CB(2)1049/05-06(01)] was workable but it might not be very useful to OCs because OCs could make use of other support measures introduced in recent years to carry out demolition, alteration, repair or improvement works of the building for the purpose of complying with statutory directions, notices or order. <u>Members</u>, however, in general were of the view that subject to the detailed consideration of the merits of the proposal, the relevant borrowing power should be made available to OCs if appropriate. <u>Members</u> agreed that the Bills Committee should study the proposal at the next meeting to be held on Thursday, 28 September 2006, at 10:45 am and the Clerk should notify members accordingly.

Recording at owners' meetings
[Item B of LC Paper No. CB(2)3038/05-06(01)]

7. The Administration was requested to seek clarification from the Privacy Commissioner with regard to the legal advice that video-recording or audio-recording of the proceedings of a meeting by attendees of the meeting amounted to collection of personal data under the Personal Data (Privacy) Ordinance and, if Data Protection Principles did apply to the situation where video-recording or audio-recording was conducted at owners' meetings, whether the Principles were considered to have been complied with by merely requiring owners to decide on the matter by passing a resolution at an owners' meeting.

Allowing owners to attend meetings of management committees (MCs) [Item E of LC Paper No. CB(2)3038/05-06(01)]

8. <u>The Chairman</u> suggested that MCs should be required under the Building Management Ordinance to display in a prominent place in the building the agendas of their meetings within a specified period of time before the meetings were held so that owners could express their views on the subject matters to be discussed. <u>Ms Emily LAU</u> expressed support for the Chairman's suggestion. <u>The Administration</u> agreed to consider.
