Action

I. Confirmation of minutes

[LC Paper Nos. CB(2)298/06-07 and CB(2)299/06-07]

The minutes of the meetings held on 28 September 2006 and 5 October 2006 were confirmed.

II. Meeting with the Administration

[LC Paper Nos. CB(3)477/04-05, CB(2)3140/05-06(01) and (02)]

Clause-by-clause examination of the Bill

2. <u>The Bills Committee</u> completed examination of clause 21 to clause 23(f) of the Bill, together with relevant Committee Stage amendments (CSAs) proposed by the Administration. (Index of proceedings attached in **Annex**).

Proposed new Schedule 1A

- 3. <u>Mr WONG Kwok-hing</u> requested to put on record the Administration's following advice -
 - (a) the Bill did not require the signature in Form 1 or Form 2 of Schedule 1A and that appeared on the title deed to be the same; and
 - (b) if the owner was a body corporate, Form 1 or Form 2 of Schedule 1A would have to be sealed or stamped with the seal or stamp of the body corporate and signed by a person authorised by the body

corporate. There was no need for the body corporate to provide proof of authorisation, such as relevant minutes of meeting.

- 4. In order to facilitate the appointment of proxy by owners, <u>the Administration</u> was requested to include the following information in its guidelines for reference by the owners' corporations (OCs) and owners -
 - (a) how far an owner had included additional information in Form 1 or Form 2 of Schedule 1A that would render relevant proxy instrument invalid; and
 - (b) the new requirements that a proxy instrument should be lodged not less than 48 hours before the time for the holding of the owners' meeting, and that the proxy instrument had to be signed by the owner concerned.

<u>The Administration</u> informed the Bills Committee that, after passage of the Bill, it would provide for reference by OCs and owners a set of questions and answers concerning the appointment of a management committee (MC), as well as a sample notice of meeting which would contain detailed guidelines on what should be regarded as a valid proxy instrument.

- 5. <u>The Administration</u> agreed to revise Form 1 and Form 2 in Schedule 1A in accordance with the following suggestions raised by members -
 - (a) to add "[name(s) of owner(s)]" after "I/We,";
 - (b) to add "(name of proxy)" after "hereby appoint";
 - (c) to delete "of(name of building),"; and
 - (d) to substitute "(Signed)" with "(Signed by owner(s))".

6. The Administration was requested to consider whether the phrase "OR PARAGRAPH 8 OF SCHEDULE 8 TO" should be deleted as proposed in the heading of Form 1, so that the statutory format of the proxy instruments would also be applicable to meetings of owners' committee. Members agreed to discuss the issue when the Bills Committee examined the proposed amended Schedule 8.

Amended paragraph 1 and proposed new paragraph 1B of Schedule 2

7. <u>The Administration</u> was requested to review the drafting of the Chinese version of amended paragraph 1(a) of Schedule 2 to the effect that the references to the number of flats of a building would not be put in brackets.

- 8. <u>The Administration</u> was requested to consider -
 - (a) merging amended paragraph 1 and proposed new paragraph 1B to enhance clarity of the relevant provisions; and
 - (b) whether it was necessary to add new provisions to expressly provide for the voting system for passing resolutions at general meetings of the OC on the number of persons of an MC.

Regarding paragraph 8(b) above, whilst <u>Miss CHOY So-yuk</u> supported the adoption of the simple or relative majority system, <u>the Chairman</u> favoured the majority voting system.

9. <u>The Chairman</u> requested the Administration to consider whether it was necessary to put "Determination of the number of persons of the MC" as the first item on the agenda of the relevant general meeting of the OC, preceding "Appointment of MC" as the second item.

Proposed new paragraphs 2(1)(a), (b) and (c) of Schedule 2

10. <u>The Administration</u> informed the Bills Committee that additional CSAs would be introduced to the relevant provisions to provide for the application of the simple or relative majority system to the appointment of members of MC as previously agreed by the Bills Committee.

Proposed new paragraph 2(1A)(b)(ii) of Schedule 2

Admin

11. The Administration was requested to consider the Chairman's concerns that, in stipulating that it was "the person who presides at the meeting" to determine the result by drawing lots as currently drafted, it would allow no flexibility for owners to appoint another person to draw lots under any circumstances where such a need arose.

Amended paragraph 3 of Schedule 2

12. The Chairman, Mr LEUNG Kwok-hung and Miss CHOY So-yuk were of the view that, although the proposed provision would have the benefit of avoiding creation of a management vacuum after incumbent members' terms of office had come to an end and before a new MC was appointed, incumbent members should only be allowed to hold office for a maximum period of time, say, 30 to 40 months, to be stipulated in the legislation, even if no members of a new MC were appointed under paragraph 5(2)(a).

13. <u>The Chairman</u> requested the Administration to consider amending the relevant provision to such an effect. He added that the Bills Committee might consider moving CSAs for the purpose, if the Administration declined to do so.

Proposed new paragraph 4(3A) of Schedule 2

Admin

14. <u>The Administration</u> was requested to review the drafting of the Chinese version of the proposed provision to address members' concern about the ambiguity of the expression "停任".

IV. Any other business

- 15. <u>Members</u> noted that the next meeting would be held on Thursday, 16 November 2006, at 4:30 pm.
- 16. There being no other business, the meeting ended at 4:25 pm.
