Action

I. Meeting with the Administration

[LC Paper No. CB(2)2192/04-05(01)(Revised)]

<u>The Bills Committee</u> deliberated paragraphs 1 to 13 of the Administration's responses to matters arising from the meeting on 14 June 2005 [LC Paper No. CB(2)2192/04-05(01)(Revised)] (Index of proceedings at **Annex**).

Mechanism for terminating the appointment of managers

- 2. While Mrs Selina CHOW said that the Liberal Party accepted the current threshold of 50% of shares of owners for terminating the appointment of managers, a majority of members considered that the current threshold was too high. Mr Albert CHAN said that he condemned the Government for compromising the collective interests of small owners by repeatedly refusing to lower the threshold and requested that his view be recorded. Members proposing to lower the threshold made the following suggestions
 - (a) the threshold should be revised as 50% of the owners present at a meeting of the owners' corporation (OC);
 - (b) the threshold should be lowered to 30% of shares of owners as section 3 of the Building Management Ordinance (BMO) only required a resolution of owners of not less than 30% of the shares for the formation of OC. It was illogical that owners could not terminate the appointment of the manager on the basis of the same threshold;

Action

- (c) a lower threshold should be adopted only for terminating the appointment of contract managers whose contract with OCs did not specify a contract period; and
- (d) the voting rights of owners for the termination of the appointment of the manager should be determined on the basis of management shares instead of undivided shares.

3. At members' request, <u>the Administration</u> undertook to consult representatives of OCs and professional bodies on the proposal of lowering the threshold to 30% of shares of owners.

4. On paragraph 2(d), the Clerk was requested to ascertain whether the suggestion had been discussed at meetings of the former Subcommittee on Review of the Building Management Ordinance and provide relevant records if any.

Deeds of Mutual Covenant

5. <u>The Administration</u> was requested to take note of the Chairman's comments that it was possible for a developer to avoid the regulation of the Legal Advisory and Conveyancing Office and the Law Society of Hong Kong by drawing up a deed of mutual covenant without engagement of a solicitor for the work.

Obligations after the end of the manager's appointment

- 6. <u>The Administration</u> was requested to consider
 - (a) shortening the period within which the manager had to deliver to the owners' committee or the manager appointed in his place any books or records of account, papers, documents and other records in respect of the control, management and administration of the building that were under his control or in his custody or possession in paragraph 8(b) of the Seventh Schedule to BMO;
 - (b) revising paragraph 8(b) of the Seventh Schedule by adding ", equipment and items" after "other records"; and
 - (c) the need for introducing a penalty clause for non-compliance of the manager with the statutory obligations.
