Preventing mosquito breeding on fenced government land

At the Bills Committee meeting on 6 February 2006, members enquired about the measures to prevent mosquito breeding on fenced government land by the Lands Department (LandsD).

2. LandsD conducts regular inspections of fenced up government sites to detect unauthorized occupation or excavation of Government land. In case mosquito breeding grounds are identified within the fenced up sites, LandsD will take clearance actions as necessary such as removal of water containers, larviciding and grass cutting.
