  - (b) consider requiring members of the Appeal Board Panel, referred to in new Schedule 6, to declare pecuniary or personal advantage on each and every occasion they were assigned by the Director of Health (the Director) to hear and determine an appeal under section 11 of the same Schedule; and
  - (c) re-consider the appropriateness of enacting legislation to empower the Chairman of the Appeal Board, or at the request of the appellant or the Director, to exclude all or any persons from the whole or any part of the hearing under section 14(3) of new Schedule 6.
- 4. <u>Members</u> noted that the Administration would provide the draft CSAs regarding bathing beach and public pleasure ground and a written response to a recent federal court case in the United States on misleading descriptors on the package of tobacco product, prior to the next meeting scheduled for 19 September 2006.
