### I. Meeting with the Administration

[LC Paper Nos. CB(2)2155/04-05(01) to (03)]

The Bills Committee deliberated (index of proceedings attached at **Annex**).

- 2. <u>Members</u> discussed the following papers from the Administration responding to issues raised at the last meeting on 21 June 2005
  - (a) Overseas experience in the appointment of civil celebrants of marriages [LC Paper No. CB(2) 2155 04-05(01)];
  - (b) Impact on the Government's revenue [LC Paper No. CB(2) 2155 04-05(02)]; and
  - (c) Flowchart indicating the work of a Civil Celebrant of Marriage [LC Paper No. CB(2) 2155 04-05(03)].
- 3. <u>Ms Miriam LAU, Ms Audrey EU and Mr Andrew CHENG</u> were of the view that the legislative proposal actually sought to provide flexibility for marriage solemnization services, instead of creating business opportunities for the legal professions. They requested the Administration to take note of this point in its explanation and publicity on the introduction of the proposed scheme.
- 4. The Administration was requested to provide written response to the following

issues/concerns raised at the meeting –

- (a) whether section 22 of the Marriage Ordinance (Cap. 181) should be amended to allow a minister to celebrate a marriage at any time and at any place;
- (b) whether briefing sessions for civil celebrants would be included in the continuing legal education courses; and
- (c) concerning the provisions in section 27 of Cap. 181, what steps/procedures would have to be followed by civil celebrants of marriages in order to avoid making a marriage invalid (e.g. to ensure that the marriage is not celebrated under a false name); and whether the civil celebrants would be held liable for omission/non-compliance.

#### Clause-by-clause examination

- 5. The Bills Committee continued clause-by clause examination of the Bill, and completed scrutiny of the new sections 5C, 5D and 5E under clause 4 of the Bill.
- 6. <u>The Administration</u> was requested to consider the following suggestions and provide a response
  - (a) to review the drafting of new section 5C to better reflect the legislative intent that the code of practice for civil celebrants was not subsidiary legislation;
  - (b) to replace "a written notice" with "written notice" or "notice in writing" in new sections 5D and 5E and any other relevant sections;
  - (c) to improve/simplify the drafting of new sections 5D(3)(a), 5E(5) and 5E(6); and
  - (d) to consider grouping all relevant provisions on refund of fees under one section.

## Date of future meetings

- 7. <u>The Chairman</u> reminded members that two further meetings had been scheduled for 13 and 21 July 2005.
- 8. The meeting ended at 10:35 am.
