(1)	<u>Clause 2(g)</u> - to split paragraph (a) into two paragraphs, so as to bring out better the two separate scenarios in paragraph (a)	
(2)	<u>Clause 8</u> - to delete proposed section 20A(4)(f) regarding Hong Kong's obligation under the Basel Convention from the Bill	
(3)	<u>Clause 9</u> - to delete proposed section 20B(4)(g) regarding Hong Kong's obligation under the Basel Convention from the Bill	
(4)	<u>Schedule 8</u> - to make clear in Group 3 of clinical waste that extracted teeth should not be classified as clinical waste	
(5)	<u>Schedule 8</u> - to replace "veterinary sources" in Group 3 of clinical waste with "veterinary clinics or practices"	
(6)	<u>Schedule 9</u> - to include member countries of the Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development and European Union
