**Betterments to be provided in the Kwai Tsing District**

Environmental Protection Department	Noise barrier will be built at the Tsing Tsuen Bridge. Subject to funding approval in mid 2007, the construction works is tentatively scheduled to commence in December 2007 with a view to completion in December 2010.	\$100 Million
Environmental Protection Department	Two sections of Kwai Foo Road and Kwai Yik Road suitable for the trial of resurfacing low noise material to reduce traffic noise impact. Works will commence later this year.	\$0.7 Million
Leisure and Cultural Services Department (LCSD)	(a) District Open Space in Area 9, Tsing Yi, and (b) District Open Space in Shek Yam Estate (Phases I and IV), Kwai Chung.  These 2 projects are scheduled to commence construction in late 2007 and mid 2007 respectively.	\$214 Million
Leisure and Cultural Services Department	Indoor Recreation Centre capital works project in Area 4, Tsing Yi. The LCSD will, in consultation with Kwai Tsing District Council, start the preliminarily planning work.	-
Leisure and Cultural Services Department	Partial development of the Kwai Chung Park project under the Minor Building Works Programme.	\$15 million
Leisure and Cultural Services Department	Upon phased completion of the landscape works by the Civil Engineering and Development Department, the LCSD will take over some 3 hectares of roadside amenities for horticultural maintenance starting this year. These greeneries are mainly located in the vicinity of and along the road leading to the Tsing Yi's Chemical Waste Treatment Centre.	\$0.18 million
Kwai Tsing District Office	Plans to green up the Government Land at the junction of Tsing King Road and Fung Shue Wo Road, and to refurbish two roundabouts near the Tsing Yi Bridge.	\$1 million
