To change the badge of the Federation of Hong Kong Industries ("the Federation") as portrayed in the Fourth Schedule to the Federation of Hong Kong Industries Ordinance (Cap. 321) ("the Ordinance").

Comments

- 4. This is a private Bill introduced by Hon Andrew LEUNG Kwan-yuen, SBS, JP. This Bill repeals the old badge of the Federation as portrayed in the Fourth Schedule and substitutes with a new one.
- 5. Under section 55 of the Ordinance, no person shall, save with the authority of the Federation, possess any badge of the Federation or use for any purpose any device which closely resembles the badge of the Federation as to be capable of being understood as referring to such badge. Any person who contravenes this provision shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine of \$2,500.
- 6. If passed by LegCo, this Bill will come into operation on the date of gazettal.

7. There has not been any public consultation on the Bill.

Consultation with LegCo Panel

8. The Bill has not been referred to any LegCo Panel for discussion.
