Action

I. Election of Chairman

Mr Martin LEE, the member who had the highest precedence in the Council among all members of the Subcommittee, presided over the election of the Chairman of the Subcommittee. He invited nominations for the chairmanship of the Subcommittee.

2. Ms Margaret NG was nominated by Mr LAU Kong-wah and seconded by Mr Martin LEE. Ms NG accepted the nomination. There being no other nominations, Ms Margaret NG was declared Chairman of the Subcommittee.

II. Any other business

3. On the way forward, members agreed that the Subcommittee would focus its work on the following areas:

- (a) To consider the United Nations Sanctions (Iraq) (Amendment) Regulation 2004 (the Regulation) gazetted on 9 July 2004; and
- (b) To examine issues arising from the implementation in Hong Kong of resolutions of the United Nations Security Council in relation to sanctions, with a view to formulating recommendations on the implementation arrangements for the consideration of the House Committee.

ALA2 4. On paragraph 3(a), the Chairman invited the Assistant Legal Adviser 2 to examine the Regulation and provide members with a report on the analysis.

Clerk 5. On paragraph 3(b), members noted that Professor Yash GHAI of the Department of Law of the University of Hong Kong had indicated that he would try his best to provide a more detailed submission on the subject by end October 2004 and that the Administration had also agreed to provide its written response after studying the detailed views of Professor GHAI. To facilitate members' discussion, the Chairman suggested that the next meeting should preferably be scheduled when the submission from Prof GHAI and the Administration's response to the submission were available. Members agreed. The Clerk would follow up with Professor GHAI and the Administration accordingly.

6. There being no other business, the meeting ended at 10:40 am.
