(a) the total capital cost, with a breakdown by facilities, of the arts and cultural facilities and other facilities which would be developed by

the future statutory body during Phase 1 of the WKCD project;

- (c) the public engagement work undertaken by the Administration since the release of the Recommendation Report of the Consultative Committee, the groups or sectors which had been engaged/consulted and the number of people involved.
- 8. <u>Members</u> agreed that the next two meetings should be held on 15 December 2007 and 4 January 2008, both from 9:00 am to 12:00 noon, for continuation of the discussion with the Administration on the key aspects of the WKCD Authority and for receiving views from interested parties on the subject.
