Work Plan and Related Matters

Purpose

This paper invites Members to endorse the proposed work plan at **Annex A** for the Performing Arts and Tourism Advisory Group (PATAG) and matters related to the work plan.

Advice Sought

- 2. Members are invited to <u>endorse</u>
 - (a) the proposed work plan of the PATAG (paragraphs 3 to 5 and Annex A) and the proposed schedule for PATAG meetings (Annex B);
 - (b) the transparency and publicity arrangements for PATAG (paragraphs 6 & 7);

and to note -

the proposed work plans of the Consultative Committee (CC), Museums Advisory Group (MAG) and Financial Matters Advisory Group (FMAG) (Annex C) including the plan for PATAG and MAG to hold consultative forums (paragraph 5).

The Work Plan

- 3. Guided by its Terms of Reference, the PATAG will focus its work on the following two areas
 - (a) the need for and the major specifications of the various performance venues defined as Core Arts and Cultural Facilities (CACF) in WKCD in the Invitation for Proposals issued in September 2003(Note), in particular from the perspectives of enriching performing arts and promoting tourism; and
 - (b) the need for other arts and cultural facilities in WKCD (excluding museums and Art Exhibition Centre).

 $^{^{(}Note)}$ The performance venues include:

⁽a) a Theatre Complex comprising three theatres with seating capacities of at least 2,000, 800 and 400 seats, respectively;

⁽b) a Performance Venue with a seating capacity of at least 10,000 seats;

⁽c) a Water Amphitheatre; and

⁽d) at least four Piazza Areas.

Schedule of Meetings

4. The proposed schedule of PATAG meetings is at **Annex B**.

Consultative Forums

5. We intend to organize consultative forums in May (see PATAG/07/06) to solicit views from the public, the arts and cultural sector in particular. From June to August, we will re-examine the proposed performance venues to be built in WKCD. The recommendations will be forwarded to CC for endorsement and subsequently to FMAG for considering the financial implications. Given the sequential nature of work among CC and its three Advisory Groups (AGs), the PATAG's work plan has to dovetail with those of MAG and FMAG. The proposed work plans of CC and the AGs are at **Annex C**.

Transparency Measures/Publicity Arrangements

6. PATAG meetings will not be opened to the public. However, agenda and papers of PATAG meetings will be uploaded on the WKCD project website after the meetings to enhance transparency of the process. Special arrangements, however, will be made for any documents which might involve sensitive financial or other confidential information. The PATAG secretariat will consult the Convenor and keep Members' informed of such arrangements in advance.

7. The press may have interest in the discussion of the AGs. We <u>recommend</u> that the Convenor should be designated as the PATAG spokesman to meet the press, if needed.
