### Para. 5 (a) Unit costs of a respite place in RCHDs

The respite places in RCHDs are provided through the use of casual vacancies in these homes, and no unit cost is available.

## Para. 5 (c) A breakdown by service categories and geographical locations of the RCHDs which would provide respite service for PWDs below the age of 15, their current number of vacant respite places and occupancy rates

Distribution of the RCHDs extending their residential respite service to PWDs below the age of 15 is at Annex 1. As the respite places are provided through the use of casual vacancies and the objective of the respite service is to meet urgent and short–term needs, there is no information on vacant respite places. The average occupancy rates of the respite places of the RCHDs which will extend service to PWDs below the age of 15 is at Annex 2.
