Action

I Meeting with the Administration and other relevant parties

Members noted the following papers tabled at the meeting –

- (a) letter from the Administration dated 28 April 2005 responding to matters raised at previous meetings; and
- (b) letter dated 28 April 2005 from the New Hong Kong Tunnel Company Limited providing further information as requested at the meeting on 26 April 2005.

(*Post-meeting note*: The above letters were issued vide LC Paper No. CB(1)1413/04-05 dated 29 April 2005.)

- 2. <u>The Subcommittee</u> deliberated (index of proceedings attached at **Annex A**).
- 3. <u>The Subcommittee</u> agreed to handle a motion moved by Mr WONG Kwok-hing. After deliberation, Mr WONG Kwok-hing agreed to amend the wordings of his motion to incorporate the suggested amendment by Mr CHENG Kar-foo. The wordings of Mr WONG's motions as amended were as follows:

Action

"本小組委員會強烈譴責新香港隧道有限公司漠視民生大幅加價,並呼籲新香港隧道有限公司盡快與政府達成協議,在未達成協議前,本小組委員會要求新香港隧道有限公司押後加價。"

"That this Subcommittee strongly reprimands the New Hong Kong Tunnel Company Limited for substantially increasing the tolls of the Eastern Harbour Crossing in disregard of people's livelihood, and calls on the company to expeditiously reach an agreement with the Government; this Subcommittee requests the company to defer its toll increase before such an agreement is reached." (translation)

- 4. <u>Ms Miriam LAU</u> remarked that whilst the Arbitrators' Award was not welcomed by the general public, it was an outcome of due process in full compliance with the law. As such, it might not be appropriate for the Subcommittee to reprimand the company for substantially increasing the tolls of Eastern Harbour Crossing (EHC) in accordance with the Arbitrators' Award. As such, she would abstain from voting.
- 5. The motion was passed by the Subcommittee.
- 6. Regarding the measures to even out the distribution of traffic among the three road harbour crossings, the Subcommittee recommended that the Transport Panel should be invited to take up the related issues. The Subcommittee also urged the Administration to put in place adequate measures to address the traffic and transport problems arising from the toll increase of EHC.
- 7. <u>The Chairman</u> concluded that the Subcommittee had completed deliberations of the Eastern Harbour Crossing Ordinance (Amendment of Schedule) Notice 2005. The Subcommittee would report to the House Committee on 29 April 2005.
