 - (c) the number of members of the consular posts of the United Kingdom, the United States of America, Australia and Vietnam in Hong Kong; and
 - (d) the purpose of signifying "Council Chamber" of the Executive Council at the end of the subsidiary legislation made under the Consular Relations Ordinance (Cap. 557).
