Proposed options for Members to follow up the subject matter

- (a) The two Panels may hold joint meetings to follow up the subject matter. The Panels shall decide which chairman should chair the meeting. The quorum will be one-third of the membership of the joint meeting including the chairman.
- (b) The Panel having a prominent interest in the subject matter may follow up the matter, with members of the other Panel invited to join the discussion.
- (c) The Panel having a prominent interest may form a subcommittee to follow up the subject matter. Members of the subcommittee shall consist of members of that Panel. The subcommittee will report its deliberations to that Panel. Members of the other Panel may be invited to participate in the work of the subcommittee as non-subcommittee Members.
- (d) The Panels may recommend the setting up of a subcommittee under the House Committee to follow up the subject matter. All Members may join the subcommittee. The chairman of the subcommittee shall be elected by the committee from among its members. The subcommittee will report its deliberations to the House Committee.
