After deliberation, the AAB decided to make no change to the conservation approach of F Hall under the existing classification system of buildings into three types, namely (a) Type A Historic Building; (b) Type B Historic Building; and (c) non-historic building. Having regard to its relatively short history, substantial alterations and its incompatible architectural style to the surrounding buildings, the F Hall should retain its present conservation approach as a non-historic building which does not require the building to be preserved in-situ. |
