Subcommittee to Follow Up the Outstanding Leisure and Cultural Services Projects of the Former Municipal Councils

In response to the LegCo Members' request at the meeting on 9 May 2005, I would like to provide the following information:

Paras. 17, 36 and 40 of the draft notes of meeting – revised implementation programme and leisure and cultural facilities/projects and population by districts

The revised implementation programme of the 25 priority projects announced in the Chief Executive's 2005 Policy Address and the overall position of the leisure and cultural services facilities and projects and population in each of the 18 districts will be covered in a separate paper for the LegCo Subcommittee meeting scheduled for 28 June 2005.

Paras. 11 and 22 – sports activities and sports training programmes organised in Tung Chung and Tin Shui Wai North

Every year, the Leisure and Cultural Services Department (LCSD) organises a wide range of recreation and sports activities in various districts throughout the territory for participation by members of the public. Last year, LCSD held a total of over 40 000 recreation and sports activities for some 2.29 million participants. Where the leisure facilities in certain areas (such as Tung Chung and Tin Shui Wai North) are still at the planning stage and have not been commissioned, LCSD will, as far as possible, make use of the facilities at schools and other public places to hold the events.

To improve the quality of student sport and encourage continuous participation in sports, LCSD also organises the School Sports Programme (SSP) in partnership with 30 National Sports Associations (NSAs). Its target groups are students of primary, secondary and special schools throughout the territory. The SSP activities are organised in line with the daily schedule of schools so that students can participate in the activities in the familiar school environment during their leisure time.

Activities Held in Tung Chung

In 2004-05, LCSD has organised in Tung Chung 92 activities under the SSP for 7 446 students. In addition, 31 activities were held using the venues of schools and other public places for 1 641 members of the public (please refer to **Annex A(i) and A(ii)** for details). In 2005-06, LCSD will continue to subsidise the NSAs in implementing the SSP and will organise 37 recreation and sports activities (please refer to **Annex B** for details).

Activities Held in Tin Shui Wai North

In 2004-05, LCSD has organised in Tin Shui Wai North 171 activities under the SSP for 6 879 students (please refer to **Annex C** for details). In 2005-06, LCSD will continue to subsidise the NSAs in implementing the SSP and will organise 19 recreation and sports activities (please refer to **Annex D** for details).

Para. 15 - IRC cum Library in Area 17 Tung Chung

We noted Members' concerns on the revised commencement date of "mid-2007" for the project. We have made the best endeavour to compress the work schedule and now target to commence the works in December 2006 for completion in September 2009.

Para. 20 - usage rate of Tin Shui Wai Public Library and the initiatives of library services in Tin Shui Wai

The average number of library materials lent out each day by the existing Tin Shui Wai Public Library in 2004/2005 is 5 049. Considering the growing need for library services in Tin Shui Wai, LCSD had made arrangements through the redeployment of resources to set up two additional mobile library stops: one in Tin Yat Estate and the other in Tin Yuet Estate. The new mobile library service is expected to commence in August 2005, and the mobile library would visit each stop once a week. Therefore, Tin Shui Wai would be served by one district library and three mobile library stops shortly.

To enhance library services provided in Tin Shui Wai, LCSD would continue to arrange block loans for schools and non-profit organisations.
