Panel on Home Affairs
Minutes of Meeting on 8 April 2005

I refer to paragraph 46 of the above minutes (LC Paper No. CB(2) 1489/04-05). In connection with the case raised by the Hon. CHAN Yuen-han, we wish to provide the following information:

The general selection criteria for the International Youth Exchange Programme include the following -

- (a) be aged between 18-19;
- (b) be proficient in English;
- (c) have common sense and good academic background;
- (d) have good knowledge of Chinese culture;
- (e) be knowledgeable about Hong Kong;
- (f) have record of volunteer/community service in the past three years; and
- (g) have a valid travel document.

Candidates would have to go through a selection interview and those who got the highest scores would be selected according to a pre-set quota. Suitability of candidates for the above programme would be assessed against all of the above criteria. Candidates would not be rejected simply based on their HKCEE examination results.
