Land grant policy and its impact on Government revenue (HPLB)	24.5.2005 (Joint meeting with Panel on Financial Affairs)	<p>The Administration was requested to provide the following information –</p> <p>(a) details on the status of land granted by private treaty; and</p> <p>(b) information on land falling within the following categories:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- cases where only nominal or concessionary premium was charged on land which was granted for non-profit making purposes. However, the use of the land did not comply with the relevant lease conditions in that the land was restricted to use by certain categories of persons; and</li><li>- cases such as that of the Sailors' and Soldiers' Home in which sites granted by way of private treaty were exchanged for another sites which were then sold to private developers for profits.</li></ul>	Administration's response awaited.
