Explanatory Note

Section 3 of the Fixed Penalty (Public Cleanliness Offences) Ordinance (Cap. 570) ("the Ordinance") empowers a public officer specified in Schedule 2 to the Ordinance to give a person whom he has reason to believe is committing or has committed an offence that is described in Schedule 1 personally a notice, offering the person an opportunity to discharge the liability to conviction for that offence by payment of a fixed penalty.

2. This Order amends Schedule 2 to the Ordinance to update the list of the public officers in the Leisure and Cultural Services Department who are empowered to do so under that section.
