## PUBLIC HEALTH AND MUNICIPAL SERVICES ORDINANCE (AMENDMENT OF FOURTH SCHEDULE) ORDER 2005

(Made under section 106(6) of the Public Health and Municipal Services Ordinance (Cap. 132))

## 1. Public pleasure grounds

The Fourth Schedule to the Public Health and Municipal Services Ordinance (Cap. 132) is amended—

  - (i) by repealing "Diamond Hill Crematorium Sitting-out Area";
  - (ii) by repealing "King Fuk Street Playground";
  - (iii) by repealing "Lok Sin Road/Carpenter Road Sitting-out Area":
  - (iv) by adding "Portland Street/Man Ming Lane Sitting-out Area":
  - (v) by repealing "Public Square Street Children's Playground and Rest Garden" and substituting "Public Square Street Rest Garden";
  - (vi) by adding "Shan Tung Street Sitting-out Area";
  - (vii) by adding "Tai Kok Tsui Sports Centre";
- (c) in the list of public pleasure grounds (other than bathing beaches) under the heading "The New Territories"—
  - (i) by adding "Kwong Fuk Park";
  - (ii) by adding "Man Kok Village Garden";
  - (iii) by adding "Man Tung Road Park";
  - (iv) by adding "Mau Tai Road Garden";
  - (v) by adding "Mouse Island Children's Playground";
  - (vi) by adding "Nga Yiu Village Children's Playground";

- (vii) by adding "Pak Lam Road Garden";
- (viii) by adding "Ping Ha Road Garden";
  - (ix) by adding "Ping Pak Lane Park";
  - (x) by adding "Ping Yeung Village Garden";
  - (xi) by adding "Tin Pak Road Park";
- (xii) by adding "Tuen Mun Riverside Park";
- (xiii) by adding "Wo Keng Shan Road Garden";
- (xiv) by adding "Wu Shan Riverside Park".
