- 4. The Bills Committee continued clause-by-clause examination of the Bill.

Follow-up actions

5. <u>The Administration</u> and <u>Kowloon-Canton Railway Corporation (KCRC)</u> were requested to follow up on certain matters and provide information as detailed below –

Clause 15

- (a) The Administration to explain what kind of Concession Property, if taken possession by Government upon revocation or expiry of the franchise of the post-merger corporation (MergeCo), would be subject to compensation under proposed new section 19B and the calculation basis of such compensation;
- (b) The Administration to review the use of the Chinese term "接觸" in the Chinese version of the Bill that corresponded with the term "access" under the proposed sections 15B and 19C;

Clause 16

(c) The Administration to review whether the proposed section 33(1A)(c) which empowered the Secretary for the Environment, Transport and Works (SETW) to make regulations for the purpose of controlling and regulating the use of the North-west Transit Service Area (TSA) bus service by members of the public and their conduct while using the TSA bus service, and the existing section 33(1)(a)(ii) of MTRO which provided for SETW's power to make regulations to control and regulate the same aspects in respect of railway services, were outdated and should be deleted.

Action

- (d) The Administration to consider adding a new provision requiring MergeCo to disclose to the public the programme of the future operations or plans for the rail and TSA bus service submitted to the Commissioner for Transport under the new section 33(1A)(a) of MTRO;
- (e) The Administration to explain the need for the proposed section 33(1A)(d) which provides for SETW's power to make regulations on "any connected purposes" to the matters set out in sub-paragraph (a) (c) of the same section;

Others

- (f) The Administration to confirm whether the fare adjustment mechanism (FAM) for the controlled fares of MergeCo would also cover TSA bus service;
- (g) The Administration to illustrate with examples how the permitted range of flexibility allowed under FAM would apply to the fares of KCRC bus service within the TSA; and
- (h) KCRC to advise the number of low-floor buses vis-a-vis its total bus fleet size operating in the TSA; and their plan, if any, to replace all their conventional buses with low-floor buses.

- 6. <u>The Bills Committee</u> agreed to continue examining clause-by-clause examination of the Bill at the next meeting scheduled for Thursday, 10 May 2007, from 2:30 pm to 6:30 pm.
