Action

I Discussion of draft Committee Stage amendments to be moved by individual members

The Bills Committee deliberated (index of proceedings attached at **Annex**).

- 2. The Chairman recapped that in order to enable individual members to brief the Bills Committee on the merits and drafting aspects of the Committee Stage amendments (CSAs) to be moved, the Bills Committee had scheduled a series of meetings for the purpose. Members were reminded at the last two meetings held on 17 and 18 May 2007 that the two meetings scheduled for today at 8:30 am and 5:30 pm would be reserved for individual members to brief the Bills Committee on their proposed CSAs to the Bill. Members were also invited to forward their draft CSAs to the Clerk for onward transmission to the Bills Committee by 19 May 2007, if possible.
- 3. <u>The Clerk</u> informed members that the Secretariat had issued a circular on 15 May 2007 vide LC Paper No. CB(1)1631/06-07 to members drawing their attention to the arrangements for today's meetings. As at today, the Secretariat had not received any draft CSAs from members.

- 4. <u>The Chairman</u> further pointed out that the legal adviser to the Bills Committee had received informal notifications from three members, namely, Mr Andrew CHENG, Dr Fernando CHEUNG and Mr Albert CHAN (the three members), that they might move CSAs to the Bill. Since the three members were not present at the meeting, she invited members to express views on the arrangements for the meeting.
- 5. In response to Mrs Selina CHOW's enquiry on the draft CSAs from the three members, the Assistant Legal Adviser 3 (ALA3) said that the draft CSAs were preliminary and a copy had been forwarded to the Clerk upon request to facilitate his compilation of the Bills Committee report.
- 6. In view that the three members were not present at the beginning of the meeting and that no other member intended to introduce CSAs to the Bill, <u>members</u> present at the meeting considered that it would be more desirable to end the meeting first. The Clerk was instructed to consult the three members whether they would like to brief the Bills Committee at the meeting to be held this afternoon at 5:30 pm. If so, the meeting should be held as scheduled.
