I. Meeting with the Administration

The Bills Committee deliberated (index of proceedings attached at **Annex**).

2. The Bills Committee requested the Administration -

Clause 46A

(a) to consider amending "carried out by a department" in clause 46A(1) as "carried out by any public officer";

- (b) to consider adding "as soon as practicable" before "give notice" in clause 46A(1);
- (c) to consider amending clause 46A(3) along the lines that notification would be given only if it would not be prejudicial to the prevention or detection of crime or the protection of public security;

Clause 47

- (d) to consider adding in clause 47(2)(d) a reference to clause 48;
- (e) to consider adding "and implementation of this Ordinance" after "requirements" in clause 47(2)(e);
- (f) to consider providing in clause 47(2) a breakdown of public officers and other persons among the subject of interception of communications or covert surveillance;

Code of practice

(g) to consider setting out in the code of practice that the disciplinary action referred to in clause 46(2) included the various stages of disciplinary actions; and

Others

- (h) to confirm whether records on telephone numbers intercepted would form part of the records to be kept by law enforcement agencies.
- 3. The Bills Committee agreed that the suggestion of conducting a research study on the monitoring of law enforcement agencies in covert operations by legislatures in overseas jurisdictions, including how confidential information in such regard were provided to the legislatures, would be referred to the Panel on Security for follow-up.
