## **Bills**

### **Marriage (Introduction of Civil Celebrants of Marriages and General Amendments) Bill**

#### **Resumption of Second Reading debate**

The debate on the Second Reading which had been moved on 1 June 2005 resumed.

Hon Margaret NG, Chairman of the Bills Committee on Marriage (Introduction of Civil Celebrants of Marriages and General Amendments) Bill, addressed the Council on the Report of the Bills Committee on the Bill. After the address, she spoke on the Bill in her personal capacity as a Member.

While Hon Margaret NG was speaking, the President left the chair at 1:14 pm temporarily and the President's Deputy, Hon Miriam LAU, took the chair.

Hon LI Kwok-ying spoke on the Bill and declared his interest as a solicitor.

At 1:26 pm, while Hon LI Kwok-ying was speaking, the President resumed the chair.

After declaring her interest as a solicitor, Hon Miriam LAU spoke on the Bill.

One more Member spoke on the Bill.

The Secretary for Security replied.

Question on the Second Reading put and agreed to.

Bill read the second time and committed to a Committee of the whole Council.

### Committee Stage

The Council went into Committee and considered the **Marriage (Introduction of Civil Celebrants of Marriages and General Amendments) Bill**.

Question that clauses 1, 2, 3, 5, 8, 10, 11, 14, 15, 18, 19, 20, 25, 28 to 34, 36 to 49, 53 to 56 and 59 stand part of the Bill proposed, put and agreed to.

Question that clauses 4, 6, 7, 9, 12, 13, 16, 17, 21 to 24, 26, 27, 35, 50, 51, 52, 57 and 58 stand part of the Bill proposed.

The Secretary for Security moved amendments to clauses 4, 6, 9, 12, 13, 16, 17, 21 to 24, 26, 27, 35, 50, 51, 52, 57 and 58 and the deletion of clause 7, and addressed the Committee.

Question on the amendments put and agreed to.

The Chairman stated that as the amendment to clause 7, which dealt with deletion, had been agreed, clause 7 was therefore deleted from the Bill.

Question that clauses 4, 6, 9, 12, 13, 16, 17, 21 to 24, 26, 27, 35, 50, 51, 52, 57 and 58, as amended, stand part of the Bill proposed, put and agreed to.

New clauses 3A, 17A, 52A, 57A and 60 read the first time.

The Secretary for Security moved the Second Reading of the aforesaid clauses and addressed the Committee.

Question on the Second Reading of the aforesaid clauses proposed, put and agreed to.

New clauses 3A, 17A, 52A, 57A and 60 read the second time.

The Secretary for Security moved the addition of the aforesaid clauses to the Bill.

Question on the addition proposed, put and agreed to.

The Council then resumed.

### **Third Reading**

The Secretary for Security reported that

**the Marriage (Introduction of Civil Celebrants of  
Marriages and General Amendments) Bill**

had passed through the Committee with amendments. He moved that the Bill be read the third time and do pass.

Question on the Third Reading proposed, put and agreed to.

Bill read the third time and passed.

### **Motions**

#### **Proposed resolution under the Interpretation and General Clauses Ordinance**

The Secretary for the Environment, Transport and Works moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

Resolved that the Construction Workers Registration (Fees) Regulation, published in the Gazette as Legal Notice No. 166 of 2005 and laid on the table of the Legislative Council on 19 October 2005, be amended -

(a) in section 9 -



- (i) in subsection (1)(a), by repealing "on the same date" and substituting "at the same time";
  - (ii) in subsection (2)(b), by repealing "in any other case" and substituting "in the case where the fee so prescribed for each application is not of the same amount";
- (b) in section 10 -
- (i) in subsection (1)(a), by repealing "on the same date" and substituting "at the same time";
  - (ii) in subsection (2)(b), by repealing "in any other case" and substituting "in the case where the fee so prescribed for each application is not of the same amount";
- (c) in section 11(1)(b) and (8)(b), by adding "expiry" before "date specified";
- (d) in section 13(1)(b) and (2), by adding "expiry" before "date specified".

Question on the motion proposed, put and agreed to.

### **Members' Motions**

#### **Reducing and remitting the duty on ultra low sulphur diesel**

Hon Miriam LAU moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

That, as the persistently high oil prices and high diesel prices have significantly increased the costs of doing business, and have hit various trades and industries, especially the public transport trade and the whole transport industry, weakened the competitiveness of Hong Kong's logistics industry and seriously affected people's livelihood, this Council urges the Government to adopt effective measures to assist the transport industry in opening up new sources of income and cutting expenditure, and to actively consider reducing and remitting the duty on ultra low sulphur diesel for one year until the end of 2006, by which time the situation should be reviewed, so as to alleviate the hardship of the transport industry, relieve public transport operators' pressure to increase fare, and strengthen the position of Hong Kong's logistics industry.

Question on Hon Miriam LAU's motion proposed.

The President stated that Hon SIN Chung-kai would move an amendment to the motion. In accordance with the Rules of Procedure, the motion and the amendment would be debated together in a joint debate.

Hon SIN Chung-kai moved the following amendment to Hon Miriam LAU's motion and addressed the Council:

To add "welcomes the Government's extension of the concessionary duty rate on ultra low sulphur diesel, and" after "this Council"; to delete "adopt effective measures to assist the transport industry in opening up new sources of income and cutting expenditure, and to actively consider reducing and remitting the duty on ultra low sulphur diesel for one year until the end of 2006, by which time the situation should be reviewed" after "urges the Government to" and substitute with "further adopt the following measures: (a) setting up duty-free petrol filling stations in frontier closed areas so as to relieve the burden on the cross-boundary freight transport trade; and (b) re-allowing public light bus owners to apply for subsidies to replace their diesel light buses with liquefied petroleum gas ('LPG') light buses under the LPG light bus scheme, and increasing the number of LPG filling stations so as to shorten the queuing time for refilling LPG vehicles, with a view to encouraging public light bus owners to replace their diesel light buses with LPG light buses"; to delete "of" after "so as to alleviate the hardship" and substitute with "suffered by"; and to add "due to fluctuations in oil prices" after "the transport industry".

Question on Hon SIN Chung-kai's amendment to Hon Miriam LAU's motion proposed.

12 Members spoke on the motion and the amendment.

Hon Miriam LAU spoke on the amendment.

The Secretary for Financial Services and the Treasury spoke on the motion and the amendment.

Question on Hon SIN Chung-kai's amendment to Hon Miriam LAU's motion put.

Hon Fred LI claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to divide under Rule 47(1) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 21 were present, two were in favour of the amendment, 18 against it and one abstained; while among the Members returned by geographical constituencies through direct elections, 28 were present, seven were in favour of the amendment, 15 against it and five abstained. (Voting record in Appendix I.) Since the question was not agreed by a majority

of each of the two groups of Members present, she declared that the amendment was negatived.

Hon Miriam LAU replied.

Question on Hon Miriam LAU's motion put.

Hon Miriam LAU claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to divide under Rule 47(1) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 22 were present, 19 were in favour of the motion and three abstained; while among the Members returned by geographical constituencies through direct elections, 28 were present, 19 were in favour of the motion, one against it and seven abstained. (Voting record in Appendix II.) Since the question was agreed by a majority of each of the two groups of Members present, she declared that the motion was carried.

#### **Fair competition law**

Hon LEE Wing-tat moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

That this Council supports the expeditious enactment of a cross-sector law on fair competition and the setting up of a fair competition commission with the powers of investigation and the privilege of confidentiality.

While Hon LEE Wing-tat was addressing the Council, the President left the chair at 4:05 pm temporarily and the President's Deputy, Hon Miriam LAU, took the chair.

Question on the motion proposed.

Eight Members and Hon Ronny TONG Ka-wah spoke on the motion.

At 5:11 pm, while Hon Ronny TONG Ka-wah was speaking, the President resumed the chair.

Another 13 Members and the Secretary for Economic Development and Labour spoke on the motion.

Hon LEE Wing-tat replied.

Question on the motion put.

Hon LEE Wing-tat claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to divide under Rule 47(1) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 26 were present, 11 were in favour of the motion, 14 against it and one abstained; while among the Members returned by geographical constituencies through direct elections, 25 were present, 17 were in favour of the motion and seven against it. (Voting record in Appendix III.) Since the question was not agreed by a majority of each of the two groups of Members present, she declared that the motion was negatived.

The President declared that the next meeting of the Council would be held on 23 November 2005 at 11:00 am.
