RESOLVED that the District Councils Ordinance (Amendment of Schedule  
3) Order 2006, made by the Chief Executive in Council  
on 9 May 2006, be approved.

## **DISTRICT COUNCILS ORDINANCE (AMENDMENT OF SCHEDULE 3) ORDER 2006**

(Made by the Chief Executive in Council under section 8 of the District  
Councils Ordinance (Cap. 547) subject to the approval  
of the Legislative Council)

### **1. Commencement**

This Order shall –

- (a) come into operation on 14 July 2006 for the purpose only of enabling arrangements to be made for the holding of the District Council ordinary election in 2007; and
- (b) in so far as it has not come into operation under paragraph (a), come into operation on 1 January 2008.

### **2. Schedule 3 amended**

Part I of Schedule 3 to the District Councils Ordinance (Cap. 547) is amended –

- (a) in item 10, by repealing “8” and substituting “10”;
- (b) in item 13, by repealing “20” and substituting “23”.

### **Explanatory Note**

The number of members to be elected (“number of elected seats”) to each District Council is set out in Part I of Schedule 3 to the District Councils Ordinance (Cap. 547).

2. The purpose of this Order is to increase the number of elected seats, in the case of the Islands District Council and the Sai Kung District Council only, from 8 to 10 and from 20 to 23 respectively. The increase is to take effect in respect of the District Council ordinary election to be held in 2007.
