CLOSER ECONOMIC PARTNERSHIP ARRANGEMENT  
(CEPA)**

**THIRD PHASE OF TRADE LIBERALIZATION**

**INTRODUCTION**

This note informs members of the Legislative Council Commerce and Industry Panel on the outcome of the Administration's discussions with the Mainland on the third phase of CEPA (CEPA III) on further liberalization of trade in goods and services.

**BACKGROUND**

2. The Mainland and Hong Kong signed the main text of CEPA on 29 June 2003 and its Supplement on 27 October 2004 (CEPA I and CEPA II). Pursuant to Article 3 of CEPA regarding its further development, the two sides agree to broaden and enrich the content of CEPA through continuous and further reciprocal liberalization. In this connection, consultations with the Central People's Government on CEPA III were launched early this year. After months of continued and intensive exchanges, the two sides signed the legal text of CEPA III (Annex) on 18 October 2005 in Hong Kong. Key liberalizations measures on trade in goods and trade in services under CEPA III are highlighted in paragraphs 3 to 10 below.

**DETAILS**

**(A) Trade in Goods**

3. The Mainland agrees to give all products of Hong Kong origin tariff free treatment starting from 1 January 2006 except for prohibited articles and the articles that are subject to special commitments of the Mainland under its international agreements (such as used or waste electrical machinery and medical/surgical products, chemical residual, municipal waste, tiger bone and rhinoceros horn), upon applications by

local manufacturers and upon the CEPA rules of origin (ROOs) being agreed and met.

4. In respect of products in which Hong Kong traders have expressly indicated interest before the launch of CEPA III consultations, their ROOs (covering 261 Mainland tariff lines) have already been worked out. The overwhelming majority of the agreed ROOs basically resemble the liberal rules adopted in CEPA I and II.

5. In respect of the products that are of no interest to Hong Kong traders for the time being, the two sides have agreed that their relevant ROOs will be jointly worked out twice a year (instead of once a year under CEPA I and II) after 2005 on application by the trade. This will provide further flexibility to interested manufacturers.

6. The Mainland also agrees to amend the existing ROOs with a view to waiving the 30% value adding requirement for watches of Hong Kong brand names.

7. Also featured in the CEPA III package is the exemption of textiles and clothing products under Hong Kong's Outward Processing Arrangement (OPA) from the Mainland's regime of export duty imposed early this year as a result of the special safeguard measures of the US and the EU. The exemption has already taken effect.

## **(B) Trade in Services**

8. Under CEPA III, there are 23 liberalization measures spreading across 10 areas, namely legal, accounting, audiovisual, construction, distribution, banking, securities, tourism, transport and individually owned stores. Details are outlined in the Annex. Some of liberalization measures are highlighted below:

**Audiovisual** - to allow each company set up in the Mainland by Hong Kong service suppliers on a wholly owned basis to build and operate more than one cinema in different places.

**Tourism** - to lower the turnover thresholds for setting up travel agencies in the Mainland.

**Legal service** - to allow Hong Kong legal representative offices to enter into association with Mainland law firms in different cities of the same province; and to allow Hong Kong people practicing law in the Mainland to be employed at the same time by a law firm outside the Mainland.

**Construction and engineering** - in assessing the qualification of Hong Kong consultants, the Mainland will take into account the experience and track records of these firms in Hong Kong as well; to relax the residence requirements of Hong Kong professional and technical staff employed in the Mainland; and to relax the requirements regarding the employment of Hong Kong residents qualified as certified architects or certified engineers by Hong Kong consultants.

**Banking** - to allow more flexibility for branches of Hong Kong banks in the Mainland in fulfilling the requirement on the level of operating funds, which is to be assessed on an aggregate basis.

9. In accordance with Article 5 of Annex 4 of CEPA, Hong Kong will not impose any new discriminatory measures on Mainland's services and service suppliers in the areas covered by CEPA. This commitment will also be applicable to CEPA III. Likewise, Hong Kong service suppliers will be eligible for the preferences of CEPA III in accordance with the same qualifying criteria in Annex 5 of CEPA as supplemented by relevant provisions, if any, in CEPA II and III.

10. All the liberalization measures will take effect on 1 January 2006, and the Mainland will work out and promulgate the necessary implementation rules and regulations as appropriate.

### **(C) Trade and Investment Facilitation**

11. The two sides agree that trade and investment facilitation plays a crucial role in the successful implementation of CEPA. Many of the measures under CEPA III have been worked out with the intention to enhance the flow of trade and investment between the two places. The exemption of OPA textiles and clothing products from export duties (see paragraph 7 above) and the permission for certain types of Mainland securities and futures companies to establish subsidiaries in Hong Kong (see Article 3 of Annex) are cases in point.

### **(D) Further Liberalization**

12. CEPA is an open and developing platform. We will seek to engage the Mainland authorities on further liberalization of trade in goods and services in due course.

## **IMPLICATIONS OF IMPLEMENTATION**

13. CEPA has been offering new business opportunities in the Mainland for Hong Kong businesses and service suppliers, enhancing the attractiveness of Hong Kong to overseas investors. The zero import tariff preference, including the adoption of more flexible ROOs for watches, has the potential to attract to Hong Kong manufacturing of brand name products, or manufacturing process with high-value added content or substantial intellectual property input. The Administration's study on the economic impact of CEPA I revealed that the overwhelming majority of respondents considered that CEPA I was beneficial to the Hong Kong economy. About 29,000 new jobs have been and are forecast to be created for Hong Kong in the first two years of implementing CEPA I (including the "Individual Visit Scheme").

14. Trade and Industry Department and the Customs & Excise Department will continue to carry out the part of CEPA work related to the certification of goods of Hong Kong origin and of Hong Kong service suppliers. Relevant policy bureaux and departments will be involved in the implementation of those parts of CEPA III under their purview.

## **CONSULTATION**

15. We have been in touch with the business and professional communities in formulating the strategy for CEPA III. Their views and requests have been taken into account in drawing up Hong Kong's wish list in this phase of consultations with the Mainland. We will stay in close and constant dialogue with the stakeholders in the implementation of the further liberalization measures and in talks with the Mainland on any new phases of CEPA.

16. We will continue to keep the Panel informed of the major developments of CEPA.

## **Supplement II to the Mainland and Hong Kong Closer Economic Partnership Arrangement**

To further enhance the level of economic and trade exchanges and cooperation between the Mainland<sup>1</sup> and the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region (hereinafter referred to as “Hong Kong”), and pursuant to:

the Mainland and Hong Kong Closer Economic Partnership Arrangement (hereinafter referred to as “CEPA”) signed on 29 June 2003 and its Annexes signed on 29 September 2003;

the Supplement to the Mainland and Hong Kong Closer Economic Partnership Arrangement (hereinafter referred to as “Supplement to the CEPA”) signed on 27 October 2004;

the two sides agreed to sign this Supplement II to the CEPA on further liberalization of trade in goods and trade in services in the Mainland for Hong Kong and financial cooperation of both sides.

### 1. Trade in Goods

(1) From 1 January 2006, the Mainland shall fully implement zero tariff on imported goods of Hong Kong origin<sup>2</sup>. Imported goods subject to zero tariff must fulfill the rules of origin confirmed after consultation by both sides.

The rules of origin for imported goods of Hong Kong origin for which consultations were completed by both sides in 2005 are listed in Annex 1 of this Supplement II to the CEPA. Annex 1 of this Supplement II to the CEPA is a supplement to Table 1 of Annex 2 of “CEPA” – “Schedule on Rules of Origin of Hong Kong Goods Subject to Tariff Preference for Trade in Goods”.

<sup>2</sup> Imported goods do not include those prohibited by the Mainland’s rules and regulations and those prohibited as a result of the implementation of international treaties by the Mainland, as well as products that the Mainland has made special commitments in relevant international agreements.

Both sides agree to amend the detailed implementation procedures in Article 5 of Annex 1 of “CEPA” – “Arrangements for Implementation of Zero Tariff on Trade in Goods” as follows:

“(1) Submission

1. From 1 January 2006, Hong Kong manufacturers may submit the list of goods subject to zero tariff to the Hong Kong Trade and Industry Department.
2. The Hong Kong Trade and Industry Department should, prior to 1 March and 1 September each year respectively, submit the list of goods verified and certified in accordance with relevant rules of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region Government to the Ministry of Commerce.

(2) Consultation and Promulgation

The Ministry of Commerce shall confirm and then pass the list of goods to the Customs General Administration. The Customs General Administration and the Hong Kong Trade and Industry Department shall enter into consultation on the rules of origin for the relevant goods. The two sides shall complete the consultations on the rules of origin before 1 June and 1 December each year respectively, add the rules of origin of the relevant goods to Table 1 of Annex 2 of ‘CEPA’, and promulgate them.

(3) Implementation

The Mainland shall, no later than 1 July of the same year and 1 January of the following year respectively, allow the entry of the relevant goods tariff free in line with ‘CEPA’ upon presentation of the certificates of origin issued by the Hong Kong issuing authorities.”

(2) Article 5 of Annex 2 of “CEPA” – “Rules of Origin for Trade in Goods” is amended as follows:

“5. On the criteria for ‘substantial transformation’ set out in Article 2 (2) of this Annex, the two sides agree on the following:

(1) the criteria for determining ‘substantial transformation’ may include ‘manufacturing or processing operations’, ‘change in tariff heading’, ‘value-added content’, ‘other criteria’ or ‘mixed criteria’;

1. ‘manufacturing or processing operations’ refers to the principal manufacturing or processing operations carried out in the area of one side which confer essential characteristics to the goods derived after the operations;

2. ‘change in tariff heading’ refers to the processing and manufacturing operations of non-originating materials carried out in the area of one side and resulting in a product of a different four-digit tariff heading under the ‘Product Description and Harmonized System Codes’. Moreover, no production, processing or manufacturing operations will be carried out in countries or territories other than that side which will result in a change in the four-digit tariff heading;

3. ‘value-added content’ refers to the total value of raw materials, component parts, labour costs and product development costs exclusively incurred in one side being greater than or equal to 30% of the FOB value of the exporting goods, and that the final manufacturing or processing operations should be completed in the area of that side. The formula for calculation is as follows:

$$\frac{\text{value of raw materials} + \text{value of component parts} + \text{labour costs} + \text{product development costs}}{\text{FOB value of the exporting goods}} \times 100\% \geq 30\%$$

(i) ‘product development’ refers to product development carried out in the area of one side for the purposes of

producing or processing the exporting goods. Development expenses incurred should be related to the exporting goods. These expenses include fees payable for the development of designs, patents, patented technologies, trademarks or copyrights (collectively "these rights") carried out by the manufacturer himself, fees payable to a natural or legal person in the area of one side for undertaking development of these rights, and fees payable for purchasing these rights owned by a natural or legal person in the area of one side. The fees payable should be clearly identifiable under generally accepted accounting principles and the requirements of 'Agreement on Implementation of Article VII of the General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade 1994';

(ii) calculation of the above 'value-added content' will be consistent with generally accepted accounting principles and the 'Agreement on Implementation of Article VII of the General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade 1994';

4. 'other criteria' refers to methods agreed by both sides in determining 'substantial transformation', other than 'manufacturing or processing operations', 'change in tariff heading' and 'value-added content' as set out above.

5. 'mixed criteria' refers to the use of two or more of the above criteria in determining origin.

(2) 'other additional conditions: if the 'substantial transformation' criteria set out in paragraph (1) above are not adequate for determining origin, additional conditions can be used (such as brand requirement, etc) upon agreement by both sides."

## 2. Trade in Services



(1) From 1 January 2006, the Mainland shall further relax the market access conditions in the areas of legal, accounting, audiovisual, construction, distribution, banking, , tourism, transport and individually owned stores on the basis of the services liberalization commitments under “CEPA” and “Supplement to the CEPA”. The specific contents are detailed in Annex 2 of this Supplement II to the CEPA.

(2) Annex 2 of this Supplement II to the CEPA is a supplement and amendment to Table 1 of Annex 4 of “CEPA” – “The Mainland’s Specific Commitments on Liberalization of Trade in Services for Hong Kong” and Annex 3 of “Supplement to the CEPA”- “Supplements and Amendments to the Mainland’s Specific Commitments on Liberalization on Trade in Services for Hong Kong”. In the event of conflict with the provisions of the other two instruments, the provisions of Annex 2 of this Supplement II to the CEPA shall prevail.

(3) “Service suppliers” as referred to in Annex 2 of this Supplement II to the CEPA should meet the relevant requirements of Annex 5 of “CEPA” – “Definition of “Service Supplier” and Related Requirements”.

### 3. Financial Cooperation

(1) The Mainland shall allow qualified Mainland securities companies which belong to the pilot innovation type to set up subsidiaries in Hong Kong in accordance with the relevant requirements.

(2) The Mainland shall allow qualified Mainland futures companies to operate futures business in Hong Kong, including the setting up of subsidiaries.

### 4. Annexes

The Annexes to this Supplement II to the CEPA form an integral part of this Supplement II to the CEPA.

### 5. Coming into Effect

This Supplement II to the CEPA shall come into effect on the day of signature by the representatives of the two sides.
