**Aviation, Logistics and Port development**

**1. Logistics services**

At the Panel meeting on 24 January 2005, the Administration advised that co-location of immigration and customs facilities at cross-boundary control points involved complex legal and jurisdiction issues. There was no plan to provide co-location of immigration and customs facilities at SkyPlaza.

**3. Development of new cruise terminal facilities in Hong Kong**
