The Census and Statistics Department conducts the General Household Survey (GHS) regularly to collect detailed information related to the characteristics of the labour force (including monthly household incomes). The GHS is a random sample survey conducted on a continuous basis. It covers the land-based non-institutional population of Hong Kong, including households with different household incomes. This Survey does not and cannot cater for the collection of information regarding households with the highest income.

Survey findings of the GHS are published in the Quarterly Report on General Household Survey, which includes a table on the number of domestic households by monthly income.
