In the LegCo Panel on Home Affairs' meeting on 10 March, the Honorable Dr Fernando Cheung sought the Administration's response on the suggestion of the Equal Opportunities Council (EOC) about the establishment of a Mental Health Council. The Administration's response is as follow:
