District Open Space in Area 107 in Tin Shui Wai

In the meeting of the Legislative Council Panel on Home Affairs (HA Panel) held on 12 May 2006, Members supported the proposed project of the District Open Space in Area 107 in Tin Shui Wai to be put forward to the Public Works Subcommittee (PWSC) for consideration. In the course of discussion, you asked the Administration to provide a plan and timetable on providing football pitches in the remaining portion of Area 107 in Tin Shui Wai which was adjacent to the site of the project before the submission of the project to the PWSC.

The Administration needs to draw up a proposal and consult the Culture, Recreation and Sports Committee (CRSC) of Yuen Long District Council before providing the plan and timetable to members of the HA Panel. There may be much deliberation on the proposal and it may take some time to conclude the consultation. To avoid delaying the submission of the captioned project to PWSC, we suggest that we consult the CRSC on the proposal on providing football pitches as soon as possible and provide

the plan and timetable to members of the HA Panel when the consultation with CRSC has concluded.

Please let me know whether you have any objection on our suggested arrangement above. Your reply by **25 May 2006** would be very much appreciated.
