

Cyberport Office Tenancy Highlights

- 19 new tenants joined Cyberport in 2005, adding 12% to total office occupancy
- As at April 2006, there are 47 office tenants at Cyberport, occupying 54% of total available office space (versus 42% in December 2004)
 - 9 of the 19 new tenants are from overseas or new start-up in Hong Kong for the first time
- Since establishment in Cyberport, the tenants have increased headcount by 13.4% and leased space by more than 20%

Cyberport is on the Right Track

 Cyberport operation has been cash positive for the months of October, November, December 2005, January, February and March 2006

- Cyberport has a HK\$500 million cash reserve for maintenance and upkeep of its facilities from the Project
- The Cyberport concept as a broadband interconnected community is now catching on in Asia, e.g. South Korea is building a Digital Media City, about ten times the size of Cyberport, in Seoul
- Mainland China is also building Cyberport like infrastructure, e.g. the new phase of Tianjin Huayuan Software Park (part of the Tianjin Hi-Tech Industrial Park)
