Written Submission to the Panel on Planning Lands and Works Kai Tak Stadium

Many years ago the Hong Kong Football Association (HKFA) office premises were situated under the stands of the Hong Kong Football Club grounds. Learning the Government planned to build and had reserved land at Homantin for a stadium, the Association applied for, was granted, and built office premises at Homantin so as to be adjacent to the planned stadium. The site was then used for a housing estate.

The HKFA interested in the development of a stadium in Kowloon therefore goes back many years and is fully in support of the building of the proposed stadium at Kai Tak.

The stadium should be all weather with a retractable roof and should be as multi-purpose as possible so as to serve the broad needs of the community for sports matches, athletics, concerts, parades, ceremonies and church services.
